VIGNETI DELLE DOLOMITI IGT ROSSO

Elegantly structured on the palate, velvety with a long finish, this is the top wine from the Conti Bossi Fedrigotti cellars in Trentino. Produced since 1961 and the first Bordeaux blend to be made in Italy, thanks to Count Federico's happy intuition. The grapes Merlot and Cabernet come from the eponymous vineyard and the wine itself, matured in barriques, is the emblem of the family's nobility all over the world.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon.

TASTING NOTES

Look: garnet ruby red.

Nose: berry fruit and sweet spices.

Palate: structured but elegant, soft tannins, hints of ripe plum, velvety finish.

ENJOYING THIS WINE

A highly prestigious red wine, to enjoy in large glasses, it enhances the flavours of the mountain area where it is born. It accompanies red meats, game, aged cheeses and recipes based on mushrooms and truffles.

SERVING TEMPERATURE: 18° C
ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13,5% vol.
SHELF LIFE: 15-20 years



In 1957 Count Federico Bossi Fedrigotti, the father of the current owners of this historic estate, was the first to have the idea that a Bordeaux blend wine would have great potential in the Trentino and so planted the required noble varieties on his Fojaneghe estate, on wide terraces overlooking the Adige river. The first vintage of the eponymous wine was in 1961. It was regarded as revolutionary and unusual, and is still made today, sixty years after its creation.
